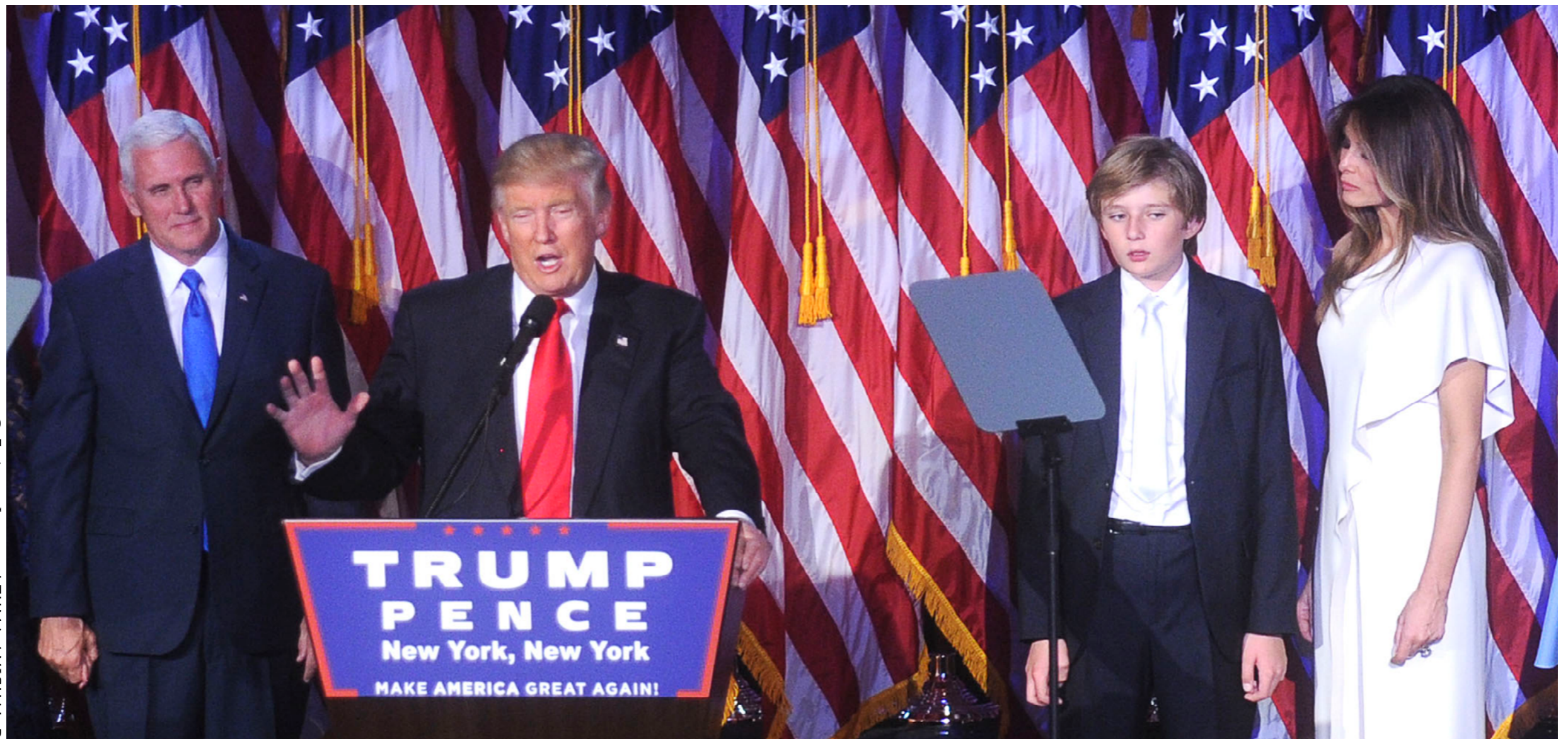


## President Trump A2
