Harry Potter is celebrating a very special birthday... the twentieth anniversary of the publication of the first book: Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone.



The book by JK Rowling was published on 26 June 1997. The Harry Potter series was an amazing success. There are now seven books, eight films and a theatre play. There are 450 million copies of the books!

Twenty years ago, readers first discovered Harry's magical world:

■ The magical school for wizards and witches, **Hogwarts**, with its four houses, Gryffindor, Hufflepuff, Ravenclaw and Slytherin.


■ The wizarding sport, **Quidditch**.

■ Harry's friends, **Ron** and **Hermione**, **Hagrid** the giant and **Dumbledore** the headmaster.

■ And his enemies, **Professor Severus Snape**, **Draco** Malfoy and the terrible You-Know-Who - Voldemort.

Readers learned, that Voldemort killed Harry's parents when he was a baby. He attacked Harry too. For 11 years, Voldemort disappeared. But he was preparing to return.

twentieth (adj) the ordinal of number 20 wizard (n) a sorcerer or man with magical powers. Harry and Ron are wizards. Hermione is a witch.



■ JK Rowling's first name is Joanne. The publishers asked her to use her initials so readers didn't know she was a woman.

■ Harry's birthday is 31 July like JK Rowling. All the books start with Harry's birthday.

■ Nicolas Flamel, the <u>alchemist</u> in the Philosopher's Stone, was a real person. He lived in Paris in the 1300s, and his house, on the rue Montmorency, is the oldest one in Paris!
