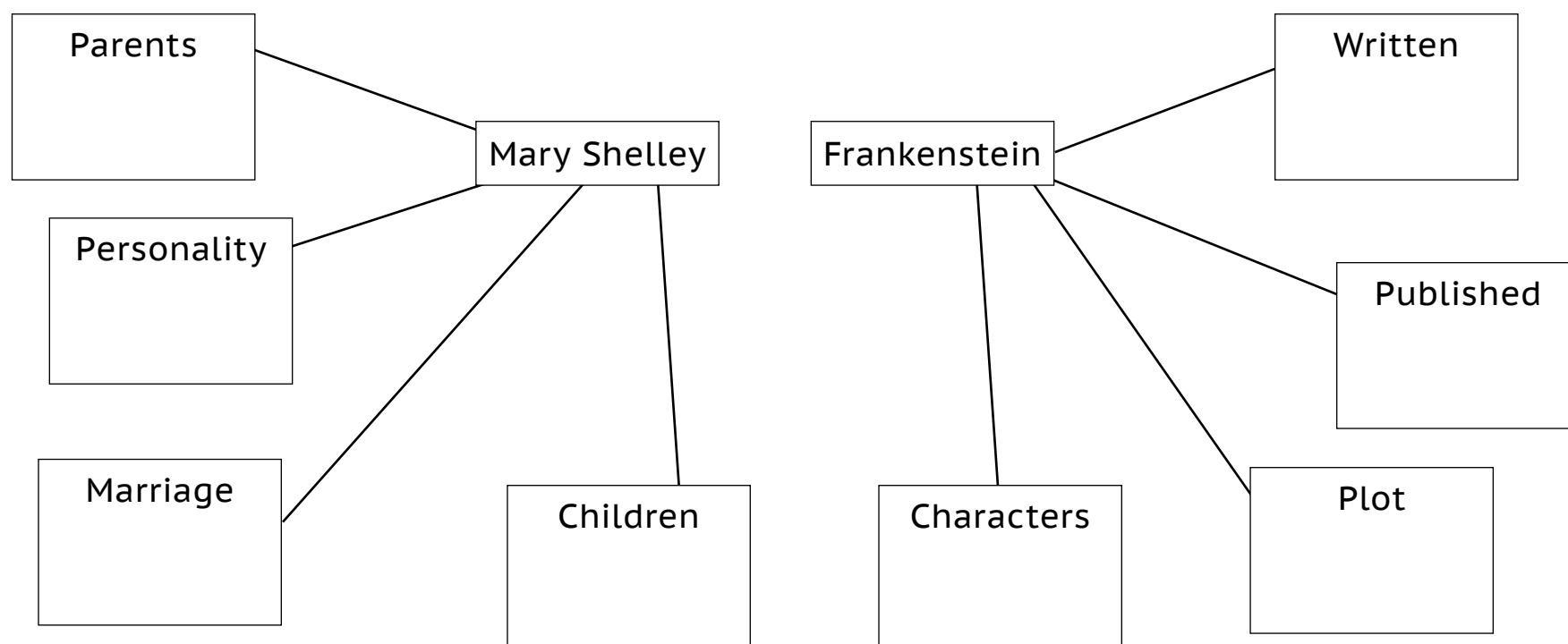
A. Introducing the topic

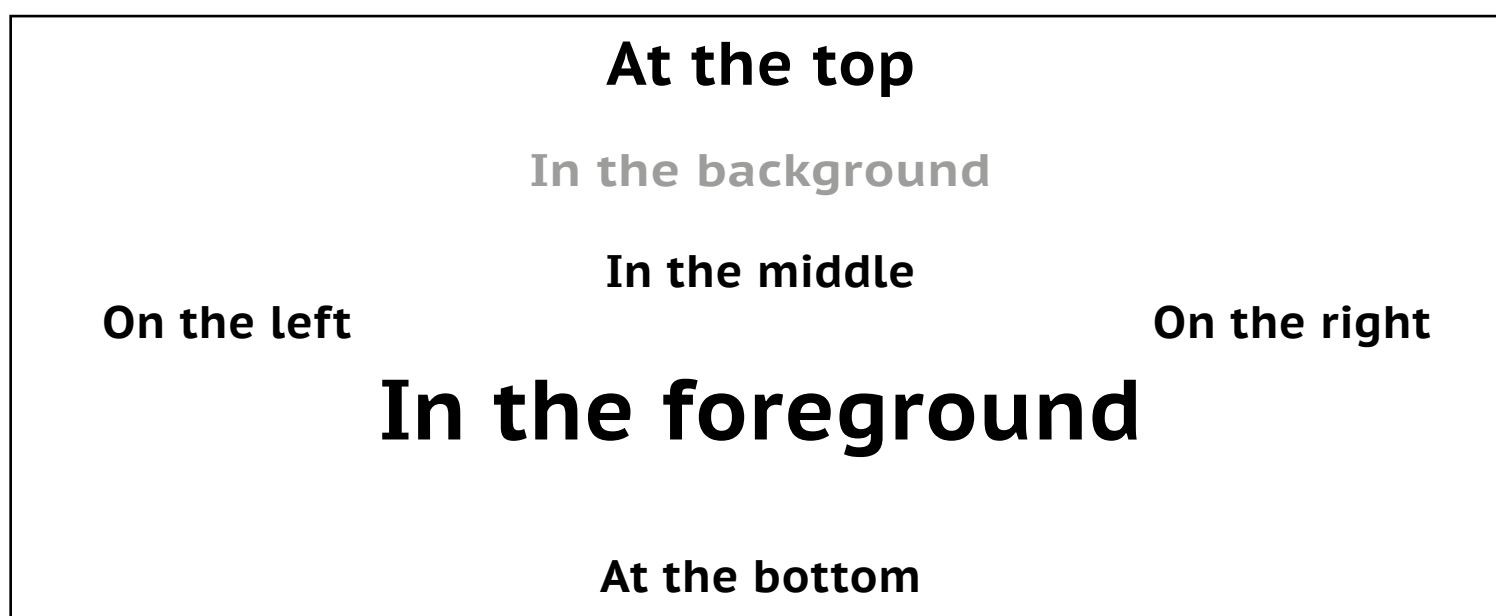
A. Lesson review
